HUNTING REGULATIONS ON ALTURAS RANCHES/MS Ranch LAND

No person shall be allowed to hunt on Alturas Ranches land unless he observes all applicable requirements of the California "game laws" and the following regulations regarding hunting on such lands. (Wherever appropriate, the masculine gender as used herein shall include the feminine).

PERMITS

Issuance - No person is allowed on Alturas Ranches land as a hunter unless he has in his possession at all times a written and signed permit on a form supplied by Alturas Ranches.

Valid Date - The permit is valid only for the dates or period it bears.

Valid Area - The permit is valid only for the particular area of Alturas Ranches land described thereon.

Non-Transferable – A permit is non-transferable, and may not be used by anyone other than the person named thereon.

Requirements and Restrictions – NO HUNTING PERMIT WILL BE VALID unless the permit is signed BEFORE you enter upon Alturas Ranches land. FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL VOID THIS PERMIT AND COULD RESULT IN LOSS OF FUTURE HUNTING PRIVLEGES.

Identification and Inspection – The permittee shall, upon demand:

- 1. Display his permit and personal identification to any Alturas Ranches employee or patrolman, game warden or peace officer.
- 2. Permit an inspection to be made of his vehicle by any Alturas Ranches employee or patrolman, game warden or peace officer, for the purpose of determining the permittee's compliance with all applicable laws, ordinance, rules and regulations.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK, GENERAL RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

Each person, before entering upon Alturas Ranches land shall read, acknowledge and sign the form of ASSUMPTION OF RISK, GENERAL RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, a copy of which form is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

HUNTING LICENSE

Each hunting permittee must have a valid California Hunting License in possession at all times while on Alturas Ranches land. However, merely having a Hunting License does not relieve the under of the additional requirement of having a valid Alturas Ranches hunting permit as described above.

VEHICLES

Use of Roads and Trails – Vehicles shall travel only upon existing designated roads and pathways that show obvious use and are <u>free of any grass</u>. NO TRAVEL ON PLANTED GROUND IS PERMITTED. Vehicles found traveling on planted ground will be escorted off the Ranch and the vehicle occupants will lose their hunting privileges.

Trail Bikes, Etc. - Use of two or three wheeled scooters, motorcycles, trail bikes, and similar machines is forbidden.

CAMPING AND CAMPFIRES

Camping and campfires are not allowed on Alturas Ranches property.

GATES AND FENCES

No damage or alteration shall be done to any gate or fence. Gates shall be left open or closed in exactly the same condition as encountered by the permittee.

LIVESTOCK

Nothing shall be done to injure, torment, tease or stampede any livestock. Guns shall not be discharged near livestock.

DRUGS AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Possession or use of any drugs while on, or immediately prior to entering upon Alturas Ranches land is prohibited. Any hunter who reasonably appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcoholic beverages may be ordered to leave, or be removed from Alturas Ranches land, and is subject to revocation of all hunting privileges.

CONDUCT

Any conduct that may be unreasonably offensive, injurious or dangerous to others or detrimental to the Alturas Ranches hunting program is grounds for immediate revocation of all hunting privileges for the offender.

WATER SOURCES

Nothing shall be done to damage, interfere with, or in any manner pollute any spring, stream, seep, water tank, trough, pipeline, reservoir or other water source.

LITTER, TRASH AND DEBRIS

No trash or debris of any kind shall be discarded on Alturas Ranches land. This includes waste products of birds and or animals taken on Alturas Ranches property, i.e., picking or cleaning of game. It must be picked up and discarded of off Alturas Ranches land in areas designated by the State of California for disposal of waste.

FIRE CONTROL

Each person on Alturas Ranches land must exercise constant vigilance and care to avoid grass, brush or forest fires.

Smoking – Always break the match after blowing it out. Snuff out cigarettes then tear off the paper and scatter the tobacco, making sure all embers are out. In the Event of a Fire – Upon discovering or receiving word of a fire on Alturas Ranches land or adjoining property, please immediately proceed as follows:

FIRST Notify the California Department of Forestry by calling 9-1-1
